Please consider attending what will be an informative meeting.



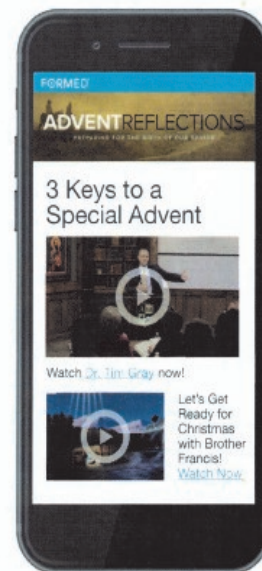

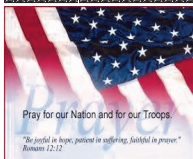
