- Need definitions added to the by-laws. These definitions will discuss the clergy (priests and deacons), ICC staff members, appointed PC members, and elected PC members. The definitions will also identify who are voting members of the PC Council.
- Changing the requirements for approval of PC minutes from 66% to 51%.
- Voting on changes to the bylaws presented at PC Meetings to be kept at 66%.
- Defining excused and non-excused absents for PC Meetings. Limits of absents would be set for recommendations for being replaced on the PC Council.

NEW BUSINESS:

Russ requested PC members review the by-laws for possible revisions. Changes are needed to help address the problem of getting a quorum for PC voting.

DREAM SESSION:

PASTOR'S REPORT:

Father reported on his visit to the Philippines. There are two new priests in the Adornos (Father Arnel and Father Arman). There are also 10 Theologians and 14 Seminarians.

Father Jason discussed the July Adornos meeting in Rome where realignments and assignments are made. Fathers Ed. Michael, and Liam will be attending the meeting.

The open parish PC Meeting will occur in October.

There will be more leadership at the pulpit about abortion. Father Jason commented the ICC Youth for Life is the only diocese sanctioned youth organization of its type in the diocese.
