Father Jason commented on how well the Our Lady of Fatima Pilgrim Statue visit went. It was a good weekend.

Father Jason gave an update on the plans for purchasing a new organ. He discussed the fund raising for the organ at all the Masses this past weekend.

- Taste of Goose Creek donations provided \$16,000.
- Donations from the parish have already been close to \$10,000. The organ bench has been purchased also with several of the organ keys.
- At least half of the purchase price of the organ must be collected prior to the organ being ordered.

Father Jason's hopes and prayers are to have the organ project completed in time for Christmas.

Father Jason's comments on the Eucharistic Congress are:

- The Eucharistic Congress campaign is being launch the weekend of June 4th and 5th.
- Registration for the Eucharistic Congress is limited to the first 750 applicants, ages 16 and up.
- On Friday, the Eucharistic Congress begins with Mass and then adoration of the Eucharist. Special speakers of the Holy Hour will give talks.
- Saturday is an all day event for the Eucharistic Congress with schedule talks from the speakers. Bishop Guglielmone will be the celebrant for the evening Mass.
- Sunday is Youth Day. Grades K thru 8 are scheduled for 8-11 a.m. Grades 9 thru 12 activities are scheduled in the evening. No registration is required.
- A procession is hopefully planned at the beginning of the Eucharistic Congress. Fireworks may be part of the conclusion at the end.
- Several fund raisers are being planned. They include bike rides, paintings, and sponsorships from local businesses.
