Russ announced the parking lot kickoff. The discussion included:

- Goose Creek police comments. If areas are not marked “NO PARKING”, tickets cannot be issued.
- Bulletin notices have been posted.
- Areas where illegal parking has taken place are now clearly marked “NO PARKING”.
- Over 200 parking violation notices have been issued to cars illegally parked. Goal is one rule for all.
- New signs have been placed in all areas of parking lot stating that the Goose Creek police has jurisdiction in the parking lot.
- Russ summarized the four part story that told the scenario of the problems caused by illegal parking.
- Russ requested Christy and Donna continue the effort of identifying illegally parked cars and to start notifying the Goose Creek police. Russ requested Jennifer to cover the Spanish Mass while Emerson is recovering from his work related injury.
- An additional assessment of handicap spaces is being made. Normally 4% of the parking spaces are handicap. ICC is at 10%. Russ is requesting the Goose Creek police to come and talk about the handicap problem. Someone to explain the purpose of the handicap sticker and who is authorize to use it. The goal is to get people to park in the correct parking places.
